bomb destroyed the vehicle he was riding in.

Zirkelbach was knocked unconscious, sustained a concussion and injured his shoulder in the incident that occurred in early August west of Baghdad. He was treated at a clinic and given three days rest before returning to patrol duty.

Zirkelbach and another soldier were alone in the vehicle when it was hit by an improvised explosive device, the weapon of choice for insurgents targeting American forces in Iraq.

Judge tosses 1 charge in grave-robbing case

A Grant County (Wis.) judge dismissed a charge of attempted third-degree sexual assault filed against three Iowa County men in an alleged grave-robbing incident in Cassville.

Brothers Alexander and Nicholas Grunke, 20, both of Ridgeway, and Dustin Radke, 20, of Dodgeville, were arrested after a call from a resident who noticed suspicious activity near St. Charles Cemetery in Cassville. Grant County authorities said that the vault of Laura Tennesen, who had died in a motorcycle crash just days earlier, was almost entirely unearthed.

The Grunke twins and Radke attended their preliminary hearing with their attorneys on Friday afternoon in Grant County District Court.

Judge George Curry ignored Grant County Assistant District Attorney Anthony Pozorski's contention that Nicholas Grunke intended to have sex with Tennesen's body. Instead, Curry heeded the collective defense call to dismiss the attempted sexual assault charge.

Krueger, Davis, Bauerly elected to school board

Otto Krueger led a field of four candidates seeking three open seats on the Dubuque Community School Board.

Krueger, who ran and lost in last year's election, ran against George Davis, and incumbents Donna Bauerly and Karen Behr. Behr finished fourth, ending her six years on the board.

Krueger finished with 69.9 percent of the vote in an election that saw 5,549 people, or about 11 percent of registered voters within the Dubuque Community School District, head to the polls.
